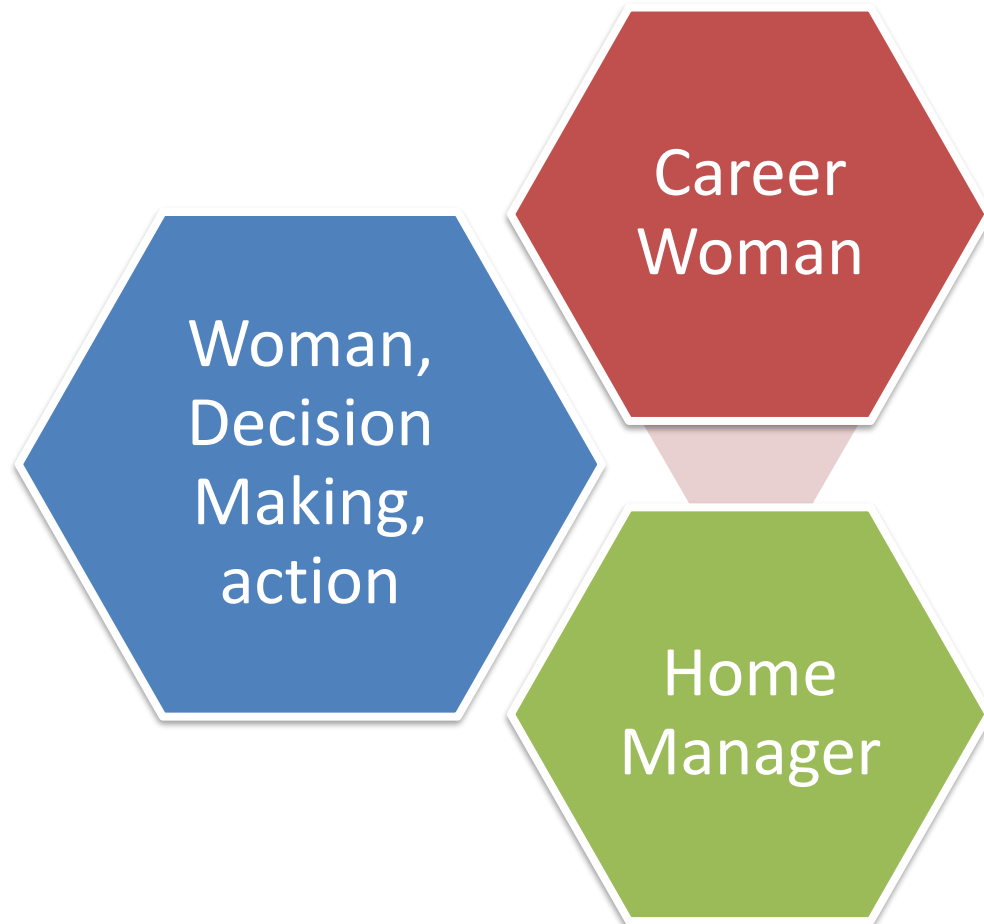

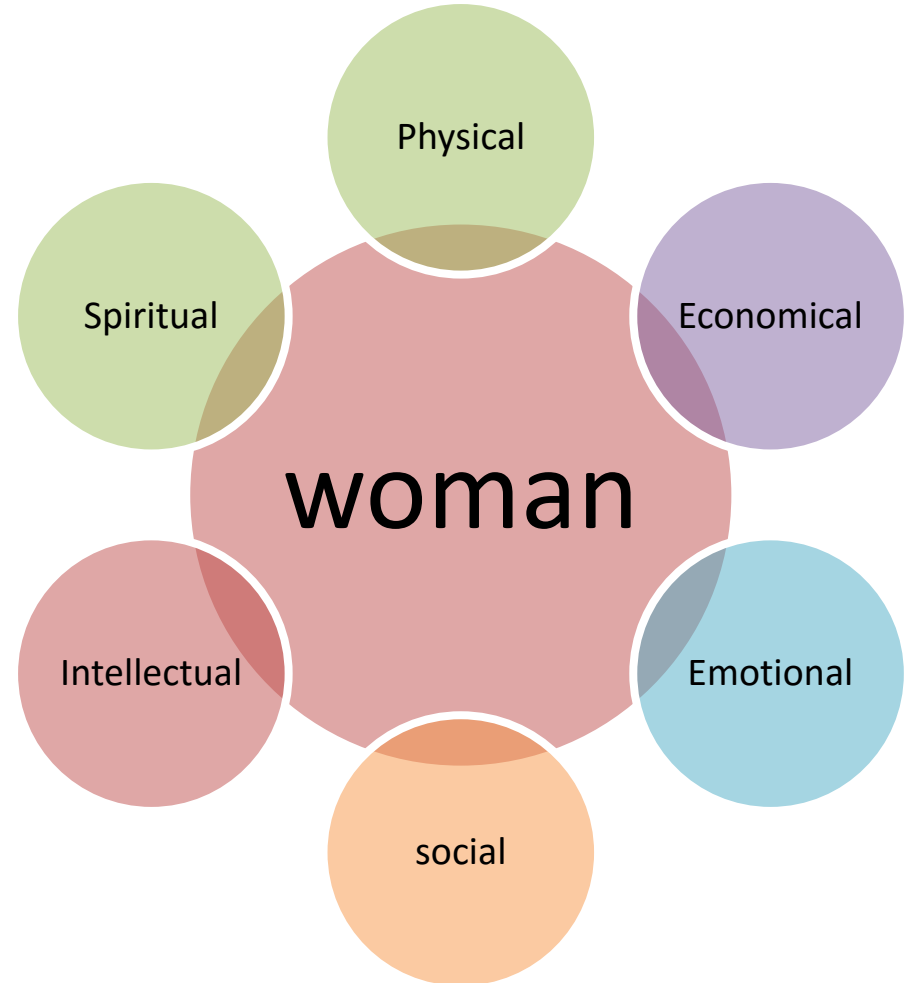

Processes of Socialization

Result

- ❑ Sees self as something inferior
- ❑ Entrenched feeling of shame and self rejection (feeling cursed by menses, pregnancy, child rearing)
- ❑ Envy of the status of boys and men
- ❑ Loathes other women because they remind her of her inferior status
- ❑ Abhors successful women whom she sees as being very lucky to escape this general imprisonment
- ❑ Reduces herself to object of play



Action

- ❑ Sees marriage as the only thing that gives her identity and pursues it by all means
- ❑ Out to destroy and bring other women down
- ❑ Becomes defined and relevant by her ability to procreate and have male children
- ❑ Entrenchment of second-order goals like (pursuit of marriage, making children, denies herself every opportunity for self growth, only goals about the husband, and children are worth pursuing
- ❑ All these things don't make her happy



Alternative Process of Socialization

- Mentally Ok (accepts she is intelligent as she can be and makes effort at improvement)
- Physically Ok (accepts she is as strong as she can be)
- Has been trained to take decisions even from childhood
- Has been trained to solve problems, even from childhood

Result

- ❑ Sees self as something superior
- ❑ Entrenched feeling of goodness and self acceptance
- ❑ Develops confidence and seeks to do more
- ❑ Does not envy the status of men and boys cos she realizes nature has blessed her equally



Result

- ❑ Wishes to identify with success whether in women or men
- ❑ Values her self respect and insists people treat her with respect
- ❑ Has other identities outside marriage (gains a form of identity)
- ❑ Gives her children (male and female) some sense of independence because she understands they are here to chart their own parts



Action

- ❑ Takes part in decision making mostly because she's been encouraged to do so since childhood
- ❑ Encourages others, especially girl children to take decisions
- ❑ She makes right decisions. Her decisions are almost always correct ones because she has learnt from past mistakes
- ❑ Brings her intuitive powers to guide her in what she does
- ❑ Develops confidence

Developing your All-Rounder Platform

- ❑ Always set goals in everything that you do.

Developing your All-Rounder Platform

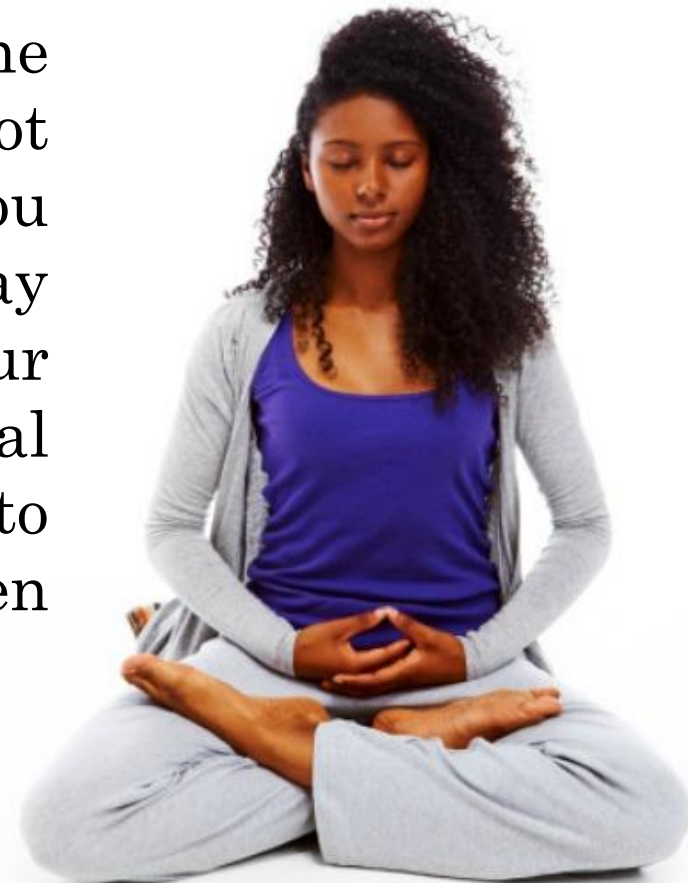
Don't blame people for the problems in your life, home or office (admit your mistake and quickly seek solutions).

- ❑ Try to decide to do things that make you happy, you deserve it.



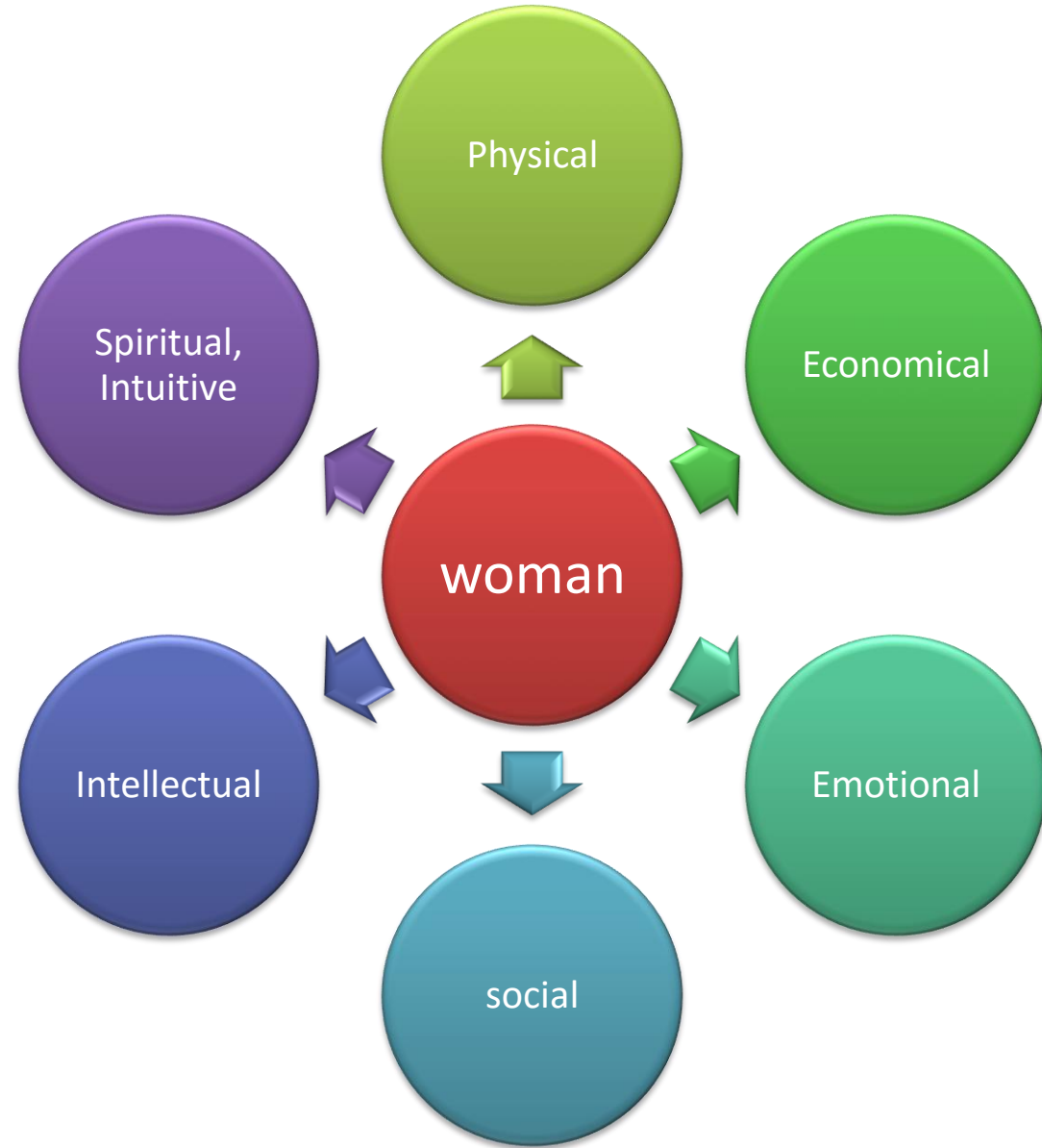
